Care and Maintenance Instructions

January 2024

A regular cleaning schedule is suggested to extend the useful life of your upholstery and maintain its' appearance. To maximize the lifespan of your material:

- Keep the surface free from dirt and debris. Vacuuming or light brushing is preferred.
- Spills and stains should be cleaned as soon as possible. Use a soft lint-free cloth or towel and avoid steel wool and cleaners containing abrasives.
- Avoid over-saturation with liquids and remove cleaning or disinfectant solutions with a cloth and clean water, then dry the surface thoroughly.
- See the Approved Cleaners and Disinfectants List for the specific upholstery material to ensure there are no known compatibility issues.

Ordinary Dirt and Water-Soluble Stains:

Clean with mild soap and water.

Stubborn Stains:

Remove with rubbing alcohol.

Disinfect:

Disinfect with 20 to 1 water to bleach solution that contains 6% hypochlorite.
